With the help of the Doorway Gallery this year's arts festival sees the arrival of our first ever CARICATURE POP-UP GALLERY.

The pop-up gallery will feature the work of Ireland's No 1 Caricaturist Niall O' Loughlin and entry is FREE.

Born in Dublin in 1970 Niall attended and graduated from Senior Technical College, Ballyfermot in 1989. He then went on to work with Sullivan Bluth Studios where he worked on major films such as " Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles, " All Dogs Go to Heaven, and 'Help I am a Fish.'

Niall then moved on to Brown Bag Films where, in his role as Chief Animator, he was responsible for the delightful animated characters in the highly acclaimed Oscar nominated series 'Give Up Yer Aul Sins.

Following retirement from Animation in 2000, Niall followed his true passion and began a journey which led him to being regarded as Ireland's No 1 caricaturist.

Niall has enjoyed many sell-out exhibitions and appeared on both Radio and Television on popular programmes including Saturday Night and The Late Late Show.

Commissions completed from well-known celebrities include Pele, Paul M.C. Ginley, Westlife and Jimmy Carr to name a few.

Currently Niall is the cartoonist for the Irish Independent and Sun Newspaper. He lives in Dunboyne, Co. Meath with his wife Helena and his 4 boys.

Letters to Remember

The Alzheimer Society of Ireland (ASI) is delighted to be part of and contribute to Nutgrove Arts Festival 2018. The Letters to Remember campaign was launched in 2015 as part of World Alzheimer's Awareness Month which features letters and images written by people affected by dementia. The exhibit went on display in various locations around Ireland and is designed to raise awareness of dementia and the challenges faced by those affected by it. The campaign also increases awareness of the work undertaken by carers in our communities, and help us as we fight to replace stigma with understanding and make Ireland more dementia inclusive.

The letters were written by people living with dementia, including advocates with The ASI, the Irish Dementia Working Group (IDWG), as well as carers of people with dementia both living and who had passed on. We hope that this campaign will spark conversation about dementia in communities and help us foster a greater understanding of how this condition impacts people.

It is estimated that there are 55,000 people with dementia in Ireland and for every one person with dementia three others are directly affected and the number of people with dementia is expected to more than double over the next 20 years to 113,000 in 2036. There are approximately 4,000 new cases of dementia annually in Ireland.

Bill Zima



Born in 1961 in a small town in Indiana, Bill studied fine art at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. After graduating in 1990 Bill spend the next year perfecting encaustic painting, having been introduced to the material of beeswax in his final year of study. The encaustic imagery evolved to abstraction and eventually took the form of minimalist color field paintings.

His technique was unique and took seven years to develop the laborious encaustic process. Bill then moved to Edinburgh in 2007 where he currently lives with his family. Bill's work can be viewed at the popular, The Doorway Gallery on South Frederick Street, Dublin 2

Prior to Eithne's completion of her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Fine Art, Eithne had studied ceramics. It was through Eithne's painting of ceramics as a subject matter, that led her to the evolvement of her unique artistic style. Using simple and repetitive motifs, painted primarily with a palette knife, the surface of the canvas is worked with different layers and decorative elements, added by scraping back through the muted colours.



“I guess the core of what I try to capture in my paintings is to portray the light and its effects on the landscape or cityscape and places we see around us, be they real or artificial.
